

ORDINANCE NO. 011-085

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING PERSONAL PROPERTY, AND PROPERTY OF PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANIES AD VALOREM TAXES AND PROVIDING ASSESSMENT, EQUALIZATION AND COLLECTION PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF KRS 92.280, ET. SEQ.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Shepherdsville, Bullitt County, Kentucky as follows:

SECTION ONE: A personal and property of public services companies ad valorem tax of 0.15 cents on each \$100.00 value of all property taxable for municipal purposes, except property assessed by the State, in said City is hereby levied for the year 2011 as of January 1, 2011.

SECTION TWO: Said levy is made for the purpose of raising revenue to pay salaries of officers and employees; for the repair and maintenance of streets, public ways, and public buildings in said city; to pay for lighting city streets; and pay all proper charges and legal demands against the city.

SECTION THREE: The assessment made by the Bullitt County Property Valuation Administrator for State and County purposes for 2011 shall be and is hereby adopted as the assessment for City purposes. The City tax bill shall be made from the county list in the Property Valuation Administrator's books after they have been supervised and corrected by the County Board of Equalization.

SECTION FOUR: The City Clerk shall take the list of all persons subject to City taxation who are not shown on the county Property Valuation Administrator's books and shall add to the City Tax Rolls all property a portion of which is in the city where the value of the portion in the city is not shown on the Property Valuation Administrator's books.

SECTION FIVE: These taxes as they relate to motor vehicles and boats shall be collected by the Bullitt County Clerk as provided by KRS 132.487 et seq. And the City Clerk be and she is hereby directed to forward to the Department of Property Valuation, 200 Fair Oaks Lane, Frankfort, Kentucky 40620, a 2011 Motor Vehicle Tax Rate Certification for the year 2011. Any tax bill remaining unpaid for sixty (60) days after the due date as established by the Commonwealth of Kentucky, will be declared DELINQUENT and bear interest at six percent (6%) per annum, or one half (1/2) of one percent (1%) per month or a fraction thereof until paid; and in addition thereto, a penalty of ten percent (10%) of the amount for general purposes shall be added for non-payment when due.

SECTION SIX: With respect to personal property and property of public service companies (other than boats and motor vehicles), the Bullitt County Sheriff be and he is hereby directed to prepare tax bills for all persons and organizations in the City of Shepherdsville, Bullitt County, Kentucky, against whom taxes have been levied. He is hereby directed to notify such persons and organizations by mail that on and after January 1, 2012, any tax bill remaining unpaid will be declared DELINQUENT and bear interest at six percent (6%) per annum, or one half (1/2) of one percent (1%) per month or a fraction thereof until paid; and in addition thereto, a

penalty of ten percent (10%) of the amount for general purposes shall be added for non-payment when due. Sheriff shall also indicate that a discount of two percent (2%) will be allowed on bills paid before November 4, 2011.

SECTION SEVEN: All payments of taxes, other than boats and motor vehicles, provided for herein shall be made to the Bullitt County Sheriff at the business office of P. O. Box 205, Shepherdsville, Kentucky 40165.

SECTION EIGHT: After January 1, 2012, the Sheriff will mark unpaid tax bills on personal property other than boats and vehicles in red as DELINQUENT and add a penalty of ten percent (10%) as provided herein and report to the City Council the number of unpaid bills and the amount thereof. The Mayor will check all tax bills and correct errors, if any, and deliver the tax books back to the Sheriff who will proceed with the collection of all delinquent taxes, penalty, and interest and will report to the City Council at its regular meeting each month.

SECTION NINE: The Clerk is directed to advertise this Ordinance as provided by law.

SECTION TEN: Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

SECTION ELEVEN: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.

Given second reading, voted upon and passed at a special meeting of the City Council of the City of Shepherdsville, Bullitt County, Kentucky on the 15th day of September 2011.

ORDINANCE NO. 011-086

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE REAL PROPERTY AD VALOREM TAXES AND PROVIDING ASSESSMENT, EQUALIZATION AND COLLECTION PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF KRS 92.280, ET SEQ.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Shepherdsville, Bullitt County, Kentucky, as follows:

SECTION ONE: A real property ad valorem tax of 0.15 cents on each \$100.00 value of all real property taxable for municipal purposes in said City is hereby levied for the year 2011, as of January 1, 2011.

SECTION TWO: Said levy is made for the purpose of raising revenue to pay salaries of officers and employees, for repair and maintenance of streets, public ways, and public buildings in said city; to pay for lighting city streets; and pay all proper charges and legal demands against the city.

SECTION THREE: The assessment made by the Bullitt County Property Valuation Administrator for State and County purposes for 2011 shall be and is hereby adopted as the assessment for City purposes. The City tax bills shall be made from the county list in the Property Valuation Administrator's books after they have been supervised and corrected by the County Board of Equalization.

SECTION FOUR: The City Clerk shall take the list of all persons subject to City taxation who are not shown on the county Property Valuation Administrator's books and shall add to the City Tax Rolls all real property, a portion of which is in the city, where the value of the portion in the city is not shown on the Property Valuation Administrator's books.

SECTION FIVE: The Bullitt County Sheriff be and he is hereby directed to prepare tax bills for all persons and organizations in the City of Shepherdsville, Bullitt County, Kentucky, against whom taxes have been levied. He is hereby directed to notify such persons and organizations by mail that on and after January 1, 2012, any tax bill remaining unpaid will be declared DELINQUENT and bear interest at six percent (6%) per annum, or one half (1/2) of one percent (1%) per month or a fraction thereof until paid; and in addition thereto, a penalty of ten percent (10%) of the amount for general purposes shall be added for non-payment when due. Said Sheriff shall also indicate that a discount of two percent (2%) will be allowed on bills paid before November 4, 2011.

SECTION SIX: All payments of taxes provided for herein shall be made to the Bullitt County Sheriff at the business office of P. O. Box 205, Shepherdsville, Kentucky 40165.

SECTION SEVEN: After January 1, 2012, the Sheriff will mark unpaid tax bills in red as DELINQUENT and add a penalty of ten percent (10%) as provided herein and report to the City Council the number of unpaid bills and the amount thereof. The Mayor will check all tax bills and correct errors, if any, and deliver the tax books back to the Sheriff who will proceed with the collection of all delinquent taxes, penalty, and interest and will report to the City Council at its regular meeting each month.

SECTION EIGHT: The Clerk is directed to advertise this Ordinance as provided by law.

SECTION NINE: Any ordinance or parts of ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

SECTION TEN: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.

Given first reading at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Shepherdsville, Bullitt County, Kentucky, on the 12th day of September 2011. Given second reading, voted upon and passed at a special meeting of the City Council of the City of Shepherdsville, Bullitt County, Kentucky on the 15th day of September 2011.
