A. Second reading ORDINANCE NO. 019-297

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BULLITT COUNTY/CITY ZONING ORDER AND BULLITT COUNTY/CITY ZONING MAP AS AMENDED, CHANGING THE ZONING OF 6.62 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, LOCATED AT CORAL RIDGE ROAD IN THE CITY OF SHEPHERDSVILLE, KENTUCKY, ALSO KNOWN AS PARCEL 045-NW0-01-005A FROM B-1 HIGHWAY BUSINESS TO I-G GENERAL INDUSTRIAL.

Road paving coordination with the approved contractor is taking place.

The sewer department is looking into drainage issues and doing camera work on Dustin Way and Beech Grove Rd. Ditch lines are not being cleaned out on private property so those addresses that are affecting water flow are being reviewed.
