
**B.** City Attorney Baker had first reading of Ordinance 020-012 levying Personal Property and Property of Public Service Companies ad valorem taxes and providing assessment, equalization, and collection pursuant to the provisions of KRS 92.280, Et. Seq. Second reading will be September 14<sup>th</sup>.


**C.** City Attorney Baker had first reading of Ordinance 020-013 establishing the Real Property ad valorem taxes and providing assessment, equalization, and collection pursuant to the provisions of KRS 92.280, Et. Seq.

**D.** Fire Chief Layne Troutman addressed the Council regarding EMS.

- i. Asked for approval to hire an attorney to start Certificate of Need. Motion by Bonnie Enlow to approve. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Deb Huffman. Motion carried 5/0/1 (LH).
- ii. Asked for approval to purchase new ESO software to cover Fire & EMS that connects us with the new Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system just put in place in the County; Kenny Newton made motion to purchase ESO Software up to \$70,000. Stacey Cline 2<sup>nd</sup>. Motion carried 6-0
- iii. Need approval of a tentative job description and pay scale for a new position (Major (EMS Division Chief)) to start groundwork for EMS. Bonnie Enlow made motion to amend job classification and pay scale for new position with salary pay scale \$75,000-\$85,000. Stacey Cline 2<sup>nd</sup>. Motion carried 4/0/2 (LH, KN)
