Kenny Newton inquired on the splash pad. Tom stated that the State required a special tank (\$20,000) and they have not been able to locate one; nobody makes that tank.


Lisa Carter asked Tom if he had a matrix of the roads that were going to be paved. He does not. Also inquired about budget workshops. No dates have been set.


Mike Hibbard asked that details be put on the monthly financials
